

He is the God of All Comfort

God allows us to go through trials so we can learn how to accept His comfort and learn how to share that comfort He gave us with those around us going through a tough time.

He has perfect peace for us if we choose to focus on Him which results in us trusting in Him.

He has love beyond measure for us as our God and Heavenly Father.

The Bible says in Romans 8 starting in verse 35---

“Who shall separate us from the Love of Christ? Shall tribulation or distress or persecution or famine or nakedness or peril or sword? Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life nor angels nor principalities, nor power, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall separate us from the Love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Again, the Bible does not say those things will not happen in our life...in fact they will...but they will not separate us from the love of God.

You may be reading this today and thinking:

Pastor---I know there is comfort from God, and I feel it from time to time, but with what I am going through, I just do not have the strength to hang on to it. I just keep falling back into this pit...over and over...no matter how hard I try, I am just not strong enough....

Let me tell you that you do not have to be the strong one...

God has already said He will be that for you. Remember trust in the Lord forever, for in the Lord is everlasting strength. You can learn to trust in God when you focus on Him.

Are you part of a church, with people you know that care and want to share the hope that they have found in Christ Jesus? Then, I challenge you to reach out to someone.... talk to a Christian friend or one of the elders or pastors.... let us know so we can come alongside you.

Psalms 46:1 says, ***“God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in times of trouble.”***

Maybe your heart is feeling different, maybe there is a thought in your head saying this comfort that comes from God is nowhere to be found. Maybe even after reading this you don't feel it. Maybe you have been to church before and didn't feel it. Maybe you are kind to others and easy to get along with, but do not know what this comfort feels like... let alone perfect peace?

Then, let me say that you are not reading this by accident. There is something more that you need to do to find that perfect peace...and to feel comfort from God. You need to accept Him. Believe in God.

Believe in His Son, Jesus. Believe that Jesus died on the cross for you and rose again.

If you are ready to start believing in what I just wrote...then you are close to understanding what His comfort is all about. It is a simple choice...and it is your choice and yours alone.
